What Is the Definition of Mentorship?









Step - I: Create an Account


Step - III

Identify the mentor by selecting the verticals.










Step - V

Select the mentor to connect and know more details










Step - VII

Fill your details and submit the Mentor Connect Form, It will use your default Mail Application to connect and send out mail to the Mentor.









Time Frame for Mentor Connect -

Once the form is submitted, the Startup Karnataka Team will connect the Startup to a Mentor that is relevant to the problem statement, after having understood the extent of the problem and deciding the number of hours it may require. The team will then confirm the Mentor's interest in providing Mentorship to the Startup.

The Startup Karnataka Team will respond to any Mentorship request within 5-7 days at the latest.
